

Common Questions and Answers for Students Attending the Ann Arbor College and Career Fair

Does it cost anything for students and families to attend?

No! Our Fair is free and open to the public.

Do Students need to register to attend?

Registration is not required. You may want to bring some pre-printed mailing labels with your name and address.

Which colleges and career services will be at the fair?

How do I prepare for the college and career fair?

Because we expect to have more than 100 colleges and career services organizations in attendance, it’s a good idea to do some preparation before the fair. Look through the list of fair participants on our website (www.annarborcollegefair.weebly.com) and take note of any schools or organizations you know you will want to visit at the fair. We also strongly encourage you to research a few colleges or organizations that are unfamiliar. You might be surprised to find that some of your “best-fit” colleges or career services are those you have never heard of before!

What should I expect at the college fair?

Representatives from over 100 colleges and career services will have tables set up around Pioneer High School’s cafeteria and annex. You are welcome to walk around to any of the tables and ask questions of the organization’s representatives and pick up information. Remember, it’s important to have a game plan before you come. Do your research, create a list of questions, and bring a notepad to jot down notes. We will have bags available for you to collect brochures and other information materials.
